

Recipe of the Week

Honey Roasted Red Potatoes

- | | |
|---------------------------------|-----------------------------|
| 1 pound red potatoes, quartered | 1 teaspoon dry mustard |
| 2 tablespoons diced onion | 1 pinch salt |
| 2 tablespoons butter, melted | 1 pinch ground black pepper |
| 1 tablespoon honey | |



Preheat oven to 375 degrees F (190 degrees C). Lightly coat an 11x7 inch baking dish with nonstick cooking spray. Place potatoes in a single layer in prepared dish, and top with onion. In a small bowl, combine melted butter, honey, mustard, salt and pepper, drizzle over potatoes and onion. Bake in the preheated oven 375 degrees F (190 degrees C) oven for 35 minutes or until tender, stirring halfway through the cooking time.
