

Recipe of the Week

Corn and Zucchini Melody

- | | |
|-------------------------------|---------------------------------------|
| 4 slices bacon | 1 small onion, chopped |
| 2 cups chopped zucchini | 1 pinch pepper |
| 1 1/2 cups fresh corn kernels | 1/4 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese |

Place bacon in a large, deep skillet. Cook over medium-high heat until evenly brown. Reserve 1 tablespoon of drippings. Drain bacon, chop, and set aside.

Heat the bacon drippings in the skillet over medium heat. Sauté the zucchini, corn, and onion until tender but crisp, about 10 minutes. Season with pepper. Spoon vegetables into a bowl, and sprinkle with chopped bacon and shredded cheese.


