Recipe of the month

Basil & Tomato Feta Bruschetta

1 baguette (450 g), cut into 36 slices
2 Tbsp. olive oil, divided
5 plum tomatoes (1 lb./450 g), chopped
1 cup crumbled herb & garlic feta cheese

1/2 cup finely chopped red onions
3 Tbsp. chopped fresh basil
1 Tbsp. chopped black olives
1/4 tsp. pepper

Level: Easy Total Time: 20 mins Yield: 36 servings

- Heat broiler.
- Place bread slices in single layer on baking sheet. Broil 2 to 3 min. on each side or until lightly toasted on both sides. Brush evenly with 1 Tbsp. oil.
- Combine remaining oil with remaining ingredients; spoon onto toast slices just before serving.

Storage Know-How: Store ripe tomatoes, stem side down, at room temperature away from direct sunlight. For best results, use within a few days of purchase. Do not store whole uncut tomatoes in the refrigerator as this will result in loss of flavour.
