In order to attend secondary school, Frederick Phiri had to find odd jobs, which included making wire sculptures of animals that he sold to tourists. Eventually, Phiri apprenticed with Moses Mbewe, a welder, who taught him how to do intricate work. Mbewe recognized the young man's talent and encouraged him to make creative pieces using bike chains, keys, and other scrap metal. Phiri creates abstract animals, such as chameleons and elephants, and is making a name for himself.

Recipe of the month

Bird's Nests III

4 cups chow mein noodles 3 tablespoons butter
3 cups miniature marshmallows 30 small jellybeans

Level: Easy Yield: 6 nests

- 1 Line a cookie sheet with foil and grease with spray-on cooking oil.
- 2 Pour noodles into a large bowl. Melt the butter and marshmallows over medium heat, stirring until smooth. Pour marshmallow mixture over noodles, stirring until well coated.
- 3 Rub some butter on hands and form noodle mixture into six round balls. Place balls on prepared cookie sheet. With the back of a teaspoon, press the centre of each ball to make a hollow indentation.
- 4 Let nests set until they are firm. Fill each with small jelly beans. (Other small candies of your choice may be substituted, such as M&Ms, small gumdrops, chocolate covered raisins, chocolate covered peanuts, etc.)
