**Everybody's Talking**

**Big book:** Paper-making experts Bela Varga and his son Gabor Varga, of the tiny village of Szinpetri in northern Hungary, made what is thought to be the world's largest handmade book. The duo's book measures 4.18 x 3.77 metres (13.7 x 12.4 ft.) and weighs 1,420 kilograms (3,130 lbs.). Its 346 pages are filled with information and photos about the flora and fauna of the region. On display at the Szinpetri paper mill, the book had to be lowered into place with a crane. So as not to rip the paper when reading, six people are needed to turn one of the enormous pages. The name of the book is Our Fragile Natural Heritage.

**Magical place:** Off the west coast of Scotland lies the Isle of Skye, on which is a magical place called the Fairy Pools. Located near the village of Carbost, the pools contain crystal clear turquoise waters. There are numerous small waterfalls that flow from one pool to another. Surrounding the Fairy Pools is a craggy range known as the Cuillin Mountains. Visitors can swim in the pools, but the water is cold, so a wetsuit is recommended. To get to this natural wonder, it is necessary to hike through the Glen Brittle forest, but visitors say it's worth the effort!

**Recipe of the month**

**Mummy Pizzas**

2 ciabatta rolls (or similar rectangular rolls)  
4 tablespoons sun-dried tomato pesto or pizza sauce  
1 cup grated mozzarella cheese  
2 small zucchinis  
4 black olives

Level: Easy Yield: 4 servings

- 1 Cut the bread rolls in half and spread each piece with sun-dried tomato pesto or pizza sauce.
- 2 Sprinkle each piece with grated cheese.
- 3 Use a vegetable peeler to cut the zucchinis into thin ribbons and lay them across the rolls at different angles – the messier, the better! If you have any scraps of zucchini left over, keep them to use at another time.
- 4 Cut two slices out of each black olive and position them to become the mummy's eyes.
- 5 Place the four pizzas on a baking tray and cook at 375 degrees Fahrenheit for around 20 minutes, until the cheese has melted and the zucchini slices have wrinkled.

The olive "eyes" might shift slightly as the cheese melts, so check on the pizzas halfway through the cooking time and reposition the eyes if you need to.

**Recipe of the month**

**Mini Halloween Cheeseball Pumpkins**

2½ teaspoons butter  
3 tablespoons chopped garlic  
1½ teaspoons white sugar  
2 cups shredded aged Cheddar cheese  
1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese, softened

¼ cup chopped green onions  
¼ teaspoon garlic salt  
1 cup finely crushed cheese-flavoured crackers  
12 pretzel sticks  
1 small bunch fresh parsley, or to taste

Prep: 30 mins. Total: 1 hr 5 mins Yield: 24

- 1 Melt butter in a small saucepan over medium-high heat until sizzling, about 30 seconds. Add garlic and sugar. Cook, stirring constantly, until garlic just starts to brown, 3 to 5 minutes. Immediately remove from heat. Transfer garlic mixture to a bowl. Add Cheddar cheese, cream cheese, green onions, and garlic salt. Beat using an electric mixer on medium speed until creamy. Cover and refrigerate until firm enough to handle, about 30 minutes.
- 2 Shape chilled cheese mixture into golf ball-sized balls. Roll each ball in crushed crackers and slightly flatten the bottom. Press 1/2 a pretzel stick into the top. Repeat with remaining cheese mixture.
- 3 Spread parsley out on a serving plate and place mini cheeseball pumpkins on top.


