Recipe of the month

Holiday Haystack Cookies

- | | |
|---------------------------------|--|
| 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips | ½ cup roughly chopped almonds |
| 1 cup milk chocolate chips | ½ cup shelled pistachios |
| 3 cups chow mein noodles | 2 tablespoons assorted holiday sprinkles |

Level: Easy Total: 1 hr 15 mins Yield: 24 cookies
Active: 15 mins

- 1 Heat 2 inches of water in a pot to a simmer. Add the semisweet and milk chocolate to a bowl and place over the pot of simmering water. Allow to melt, stirring occasionally, 4 to 5 minutes.
- 2 Meanwhile, add the noodles, almonds and pistachios to a large bowl and set aside.
- 3 When the chocolate has melted completely, pour over the noodle and nut mixture. Mix until everything is well coated in the melted chocolate.
- 4 Using 2 spoons, drop tablespoon mounds onto 2 parchment-lined baking sheets. Sprinkle the holiday sprinkles over the top. Allow to dry completely before storing, about 1 hour.
