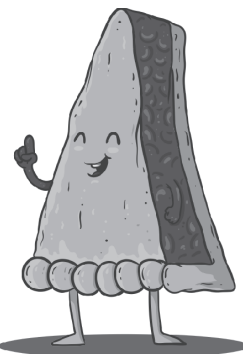

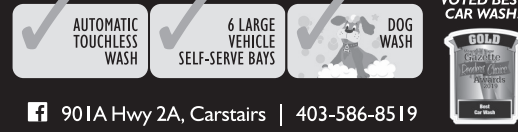

- Bake for 20 minutes in the preheated oven, until the bacon is cooked through.
