



 Fold in chocolate mixture and vanilla, then flour mixture. Pour

into pan. Bake until toothpick inserted near centre comes out almost clean, 28 to 32 minutes.

6 Once cool, cut brownies into hearts freehand or using a heart-shaped cookie cutter. (Tip: Don't let the trimmings go to waste – you can even crumble them onto a sundae!)




