**Recipe of the month**

**Cheesy Broccoli Soup in a Bread Bowl**

1/4 cup butter, cubed  
1/2 cup chopped onion  
2 garlic cloves, minced  
4 cups fresh broccoli florets (about 8 ounces)  
1 large carrot, finely chopped  
3 cups chicken stock  
2 cups half-and-half cream  
2 bay leaves  
1/2 teaspoon salt  
1/4 teaspoon ground nutmeg

1/4 teaspoon pepper  
1/4 cup cornstarch  
1/4 cup water or additional chicken stock  
2-1/2 cups shredded cheddar cheese  
6 small round bread loaves (about 8 ounces each), optional  
Optional toppings: Crumbled cooked bacon, additional shredded cheddar cheese, ground nutmeg and pepper

Prep Time: 15 mins. Cook time: 30 mins. Yield: 6 servings

1. In a 6-qt. stockpot, heat butter over medium heat; sauté onion and garlic until tender, 6-8 minutes. Stir in broccoli, carrot, stock, cream and seasonings; bring to a boil. Simmer, uncovered, until vegetables are tender, 10-12 minutes.  
2. Mix cornstarch and water until smooth; stir into soup. Bring to a boil, stirring occasionally; cook and stir until thickened, 1-2 minutes. Remove bay leaves. Stir in cheese until melted.  
3. If using bread bowls, cut a slice off the top of each bread loaf; hollow out bottoms, leaving 1/4-in.-thick shells (save removed bread for another use). Fill with soup just before serving.  
4. If desired, serve soup with toppings.

**Purple paradise:** Those who like the colour purple now have a must-see destination to put on their wish lists: Banwol Island and Parkji Island in Sinan-gun, South Jeolla Province, South Korea. Authorities on these islands have planted lavender fields and various trees with purple flowers, and they are developing an infrastructure painted with purple. The two islands are connected via a purple footbridge, and some of the roads have been splashed with violet paint. Homeowners have even joined the action by painting their houses various shades of this vibrant colour.
