## Recipe of the month

### Baked Ham with Cherry Sauce

1 fully cooked bone-in ham (6 to 8 pounds) 1/2 cup sugar  
1 cup packed brown sugar 1 cup cold water  
3 tablespoons maple syrup 1 can (15 ounces) pitted dark sweet cherries, undrained  
1 teaspoon ground mustard 2 tablespoons lemon juice  
3 tablespoons cornstarch 1 teaspoon almond extract

Prep Time: 10 mins. Bake time: 1 hour 45 mins.  
Yield: 12 servings

1 Preheat oven to 325°. Place ham on a rack in a roasting pan. Using a sharp knife, score surface of ham with 1/4-in.-deep cuts in a diamond pattern. Mix brown sugar, syrup and mustard; rub over ham and press into cuts. Bake, covered, until a thermometer reads 140°, 1-3/4 to 2 hours.

2 In a small saucepan, mix cornstarch, sugar and water until smooth. Add cherries; bring to a boil. Cook and stir until thickened, 1-2 minutes. Remove from heat; stir in lemon juice and almond extract. Serve warm with ham.

Recipe of the month

**Breakfast Pies**

3/4 lb breakfast sausage 1 can (12 ounce) refrigerated biscuit dough  
1/8 cup minced onion 3 tablespoons milk  
1/8 cup minced green bell pepper 1/2 cup shredded Colby-Monterey Jack cheese  
3 eggs, beaten

Prep: 20 m Cook: 20 m Ready in: 40 m

- 1 Preheat oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C).
- 2 In a large, deep skillet over medium-high heat, combine sausage, onion and green pepper. Cook until sausage is evenly brown. Drain, crumble, and set aside.
- 3 Separate the dough into 10 individual biscuits. Flatten each biscuit out, then line the bottom and sides of 10 muffin cups. Evenly distribute sausage mixture between the cups. Mix together the eggs and milk, and divide between the cups. Sprinkle tops with shredded cheese.
- 4 Bake in preheated oven for 18 to 20 minutes, or until filling is set.

Helpful Tip: Aluminum foil helps keep food moist, ensures it cooks evenly, keeps leftovers fresh, and makes clean-up easy.
