It wasn't long before the police discovered that Harada had played this game several years earlier and had been caught. He paid compensation for the tires and didn't go to jail, but none of the ladies was interested in dating him.

**Pandemic dress:** Peyton Manker was not able to wear her homemade dress to her high school prom, which was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. However, lots of people saw her unique dress on social media. **Recipe of the month**  
**Baked Ham with Cherry Sauce**  
1 fully cooked bone-in ham (6 to 8 pounds) 1/2 cup sugar  
1 cup cold water  
1 cup packed brown sugar 1 can (15 ounces) pitted dark sweet cherries, undrained  
3 tablespoons maple syrup 2 tablespoons lemon juice  
1 teaspoon ground mustard 1 teaspoon almond extract  
3 tablespoons cornstarch  
Prep Time: 10 mins. Bake time: 1 hour 45 mins.  
Yield: 12 servings  
1 Preheat oven to 325°. Place ham on a rack in a roasting pan. Using a sharp knife, score surface of ham with 1/4-in.-deep cuts in a diamond pattern. Mix brown sugar, syrup and mustard; rub over ham and press into cuts. Bake, covered, until a thermometer reads 140°, 1-3/4 to 2 hours.  
2 In a small saucepan, mix cornstarch, sugar and water until smooth. Add cherries; bring to a boil. Cook and stir until thickened, 1-2 minutes. Remove from heat; stir in lemon juice and almond extract. Serve warm with ham.
