Dating game: If you are trying to meet that special someone, it's best not to damage their property in the process. But that's what Yoshito Harada of Aichi Prefecture, Japan, did. Recently, one of his targets remembered him from a previous tire-slashing incident, and she called the cops. It wasn't long before the police discovered that Harada had played this game several years earlier and had been caught. He paid compensation for the tires and didn't go to jail, but none of the ladies was interested in dating him.

Pandemic dress: Peyton Manker was not able to wear her homemade dress to her high school prom, which was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. However, lots of people saw her unique dress on social media. Manker, of Sparta, Illinois (U.S.), decided to enter a contest to make her dress out of duct tape, and she succeeded beyond her wildest dreams. Its top is slightly higher than the building.

Recipe of the month

Spring Pea Pasta

1 pound pasta 2 lemons - zest and 1/4 cup juice
3-4 cups fresh peas 1/2 cup juice
5 scallions, thinly sliced 2 cups fresh pea shoots, baby spinach or arugula
1 shallot, very finely diced 1 teaspoon salt (plus more to taste)
1 cup chopped fresh mint 1/2 teaspoon pepper
1 cup chopped Italian parsley 1 tablespoon truffle oil
1/2 cup olive oil Optional: goat cheese crumbles

Prep Time: 15 mins. Cook time: 10 mins. Yield: 4 (main) or 8 (side)

- 1 Boil pasta in a generous amount of salted water per directions.
- 2 During the very last minute of cooking, if serving this as a warm entrée, add the peas to the pasta and just lightly blanch.
- 3 While the pasta is cooking, prep the rest of the ingredients.
- 4 Chop the scallions, shallots and herbs.
- 5 Zest two lemons, and measure out 1/4 cup lemon juice.
- 6 Once the pasta is just about done, add the peas to the boiling pasta water and blanch for one minute, or just until bright green. Immediately drain, place pasta and peas in large bowl, drizzle with olive oil, lemon juice and season with 1 tsp salt and 1/2 tsp pepper.
- 7 Toss in the pea shoots (or other greens) and add the scallions, shallot, herbs and lemon zest. Stir.
- 8 Taste, adjusting salt and lemon juice, adding more of both, if necessary.
- 9 Drizzle with truffle oil; serve immediately.

If making this as a pasta salad, rinse pasta and peas in very cold water to stop the peas from cooking any longer. Add goat cheese right before serving.
