Pandemic dress: Peyton Manker was not able to wear her homemade dress to her high school prom, which was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. However, lots of people saw her unique dress on social media. Recipe of the month

Baked Ham with Cherry Sauce

1 fully cooked bone-in ham (6 to 8 pounds) ½ cup sugar
1 cup packed brown sugar 1 cup cold water
3 tablespoons maple syrup 1 can (15 ounces) pitted dark sweet cherries, undrained
1 teaspoon ground mustard 2 tablespoons lemon juice
3 tablespoons cornstarch 1 teaspoon almond extract

Prep Time: 10 mins. Bake time: 1 hour 45 mins.
Yield: 12 servings

- Preheat oven to 325°. Place ham on a rack in a roasting pan. Using a sharp knife, score surface of ham with 1/4-in.-deep cuts in a diamond pattern. Mix brown sugar, syrup and mustard; rub over ham and press into cuts. Bake, covered, until a thermometer reads 140°, 1-3/4 to 2 hours.
- In a small saucepan, mix cornstarch, sugar and water until smooth. Add cherries; bring to a boil. Cook and stir until thickened, 1-2 minutes. Remove from heat; stir in lemon juice and almond extract. Serve warm with ham.
