Everybody's Talking

Hot springs: In the Tuscan region of Italy, a natural hot spring near Saturnia is a sight to behold. Called Cascate del Mulino, which means "Waterfalls of the Mill," this hot spot features natural white limestone pools over which warm water flows. The turquoise liquid, at a constant 37°C (98.6°F), comes from an underground source and is full of minerals and sulphur. This beautiful natural wonder is free for users and is located downstream from a tourist complex called Terme di Saturnia Spa, where an entrance fee must be paid. The best time to visit is in fall, winter, or early spring when it is less crowded.

Nutty creation: Usually seen in landscape architecture, a gabion wall is a wire cage filled with material such as rocks or stones. But what about using such a structure as a centrepiece inside a home? Yerce Architecture and ZAAS, two Turkish design companies, did just that. A photographer, who is their client, lived in a loft apartment and wanted a natural component in the interior surroundings. The result is an accent wall like no other—a metal cage filled with walnuts. Although unconventional, the wall brings warmth from the colour of the walnuts, as well as an interesting texture that works with the streamlined furnishings.

Flower cakes: Those walking into Julie Simon Cakes in Los Angeles, California (U.S.), would be forgiven if they thought a flower arrangement on display was real. In fact, the flowers in this confectioner's shop are cakes made by Simon herself. Her designs are so intricate that viewers would swear they are looking at a cluster of peonies, a vase of tulips, or a container full of a variety of blossoms. Simon's cakes have attracted a lot of attention since she quit her corporate job in 2018. Even celebrities order cakes from her for a child's birthday or a friend's anniversary.

Fishing pool: With travel at a standstill during the COVID-19 pandemic, hotels around the world have seen a huge decrease in business. To make ends meet, the Aveda Resort, a luxury hotel in Kumarakom, Kerala, India, tried a novel approach to maintain some of its income. They repurposed the hotel's pool as a fish farm. The large pool was drained and filled with fresh water, then loaded with 16,000 young pearl spot fish. The fish can be harvested and sold, raising money to help with the hotel's expenses. The project has also helped to keep hotel staff busy.
