Everybody's Talking

Disguised buns: A schoolteacher who lives in Ho Chi Minh City, Vietnam, has a hobby that is drawing attention. She likes to bake, and one of her specialties is steamed buns—with a twist! Once the buns are made, she decorates the outside to make them appear to be tangerines. When people see one, they want to pick it up and peel it. But instead of finding juicy tangerine segments, they are surprised to discover a spongy, soft, steamed bun inside. Through research, Le Thuy taught herself to make the buns. She has also decorated the outside to make her creations look like freshly dug potatoes

Gutsy thief: A conman tried to steal a fancy car and a handful of Rolex watches, but he didn't get away with it. Casey William Kelley gave the salesman at a Porsche dealership in Destin, Florida (U.S.), a fake cheque for almost \$140,000 (USD). He had printed the cheque on his home printer. It is rarely seen.

Recipe of the month

Spring Pea Pasta



1 pound pasta
3-4 cups fresh peas
5 scallions, thinly sliced
1 shallot, very finely diced
1 cup chopped fresh mint
1 cup chopped Italian parsley
½ cup olive oil

2 lemons – zest and ¼ cup juice
2 cups fresh pea shoots, baby spinach or arugula
1 teaspoon salt (plus more to taste)
½ teaspoon pepper
1 tablespoon truffle oil
Optional: goat cheese crumbles

Prep Time: 15 mins. Cook time: 10 mins. Yield: 4 (main) or 8 (side)

- Boil pasta in a generous amount of salted water per directions.
- During the very last minute of cooking, if serving this as a warm entrée, add the peas to the pasta and just lightly blanch.
- While the pasta is cooking, prep the rest of the ingredients.
- Chop the scallions, shallots and herbs.
- Zest two lemons, and measure out ¼ cup lemon juice.
- Once the pasta is just about done, add the peas to the boiling pasta water and blanch for one minute, or just until bright green. Immediately drain, place pasta and peas in large bowl, drizzle with olive oil, lemon juice and season with 1 tsp salt and ½ tsp pepper.
- Toss in the pea shoots (or other greens) and add the scallions, shallot, herbs and lemon zest. Stir.
- Taste, adjusting salt and lemon juice, adding more of both, if necessary.
- Drizzle with truffle oil; serve immediately.

If making this as a pasta salad, rinse pasta and peas in very cold water to stop the peas from cooking any longer. Add goat cheese right before serving.
