Prep Time: 15 mins. Cook time: 10 mins. Yield: 4 (main) or 8 (side)
Boil pasta in a generous amount of salted water per directions.
During the very last minute of cooking, if serving this as a warm entrée, add the peas to the pasta and just lightly blanch.
While the pasta is cooking, prep the rest of the ingredients.
Chop the scallions, shallots and herbs.

Toss in the pea shots (or other greens) and add the scallions, shallot, herbs and lemon zest. Stir.
Taste, adjusting salt and lemon juice, adding more of both, if necessary.
