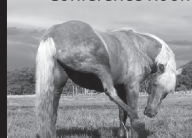

Everybody's Talking

Well-dressed: James Maina Mwangi of Nairobi, Kenya, came from a poor family and didn't have very many clothes as a child. Grandma's pies may have tasted delicious, but Ko's work also appeals to the eye. One blueberry pie, dubbed "flour power," uses dozens of six-sided dough bits to hold blue petals. Others feature swirls of food-coloured dough strands or shapes that are formed into unbelievable patterns. The resulting pies are almost too incredible to eat!

Much ado about nothing: Some people may wonder what the social media world is coming to after they hear about a video posted by Muhammad Didit of Indonesia. The young man decided to post a video of himself doing absolutely nothing. He shows himself sitting on a couch and staring into the camera for over two hours! The weird thing is that the video has garnered hundreds of thousands of views and has motivated other people to do the same thing for even longer periods of time.

Recipe of the month

Spring Pea Pasta



1 pound pasta
3-4 cups fresh peas
5 shallots, thinly sliced
1 shallot, very finely diced
1 cup chopped fresh mint
1 cup chopped Italian parsley
½ cup olive oil

2 lemons – zest and ¼ cup juice
2 cups fresh pea shoots, baby spinach or arugula
1 teaspoon salt (plus more to taste)
½ teaspoon pepper
1 tablespoon truffle oil
Optional: goat cheese crumbles

Prep Time: 15 mins. Cook time: 10 mins. Yield: 4 (main) or 8 (side)

- Boil pasta in a generous amount of salted water per directions.
- During the very last minute of cooking, if serving this as a warm entrée, add the peas to the pasta and just lightly blanch.
- While the pasta is cooking, prep the rest of the ingredients.
- Chop the shallots, shallots and herbs.
- Zest two lemons, and measure out ¼ cup lemon juice.
- Once the pasta is just about done, add the peas to the boiling pasta water and blanch for one minute, or just until bright green. Immediately drain, place pasta and peas in large bowl, drizzle with olive oil, lemon juice and season with 1 tsp salt and ½ tsp pepper.
- Toss in the pea shoots (or other greens) and add the shallots, shallot, herbs and lemon zest. Stir.
- Taste, adjusting salt and lemon juice, adding more of both, if necessary.
- Drizzle with truffle oil; serve immediately.

If making this as a pasta salad, rinse pasta and peas in very cold water to stop the peas from cooking any longer. Add goat cheese right before serving.
