

Careful preparation: In many countries, it is illegal to sell and cook a poisonous mushroom called the false morel (Gyromitra esculenta). However, despite the dangers of consuming this mushroom, people in Finland love them. False morels contain a toxin that causes illness. Rare road: a highway off-ramp runs right through it. The Gate Tower Building and its highway ramp were completed in the early 1990s. The employees working in the building don't have to worry about excess traffic noise because noise-proof walls and floors were used in the construction. Plus, the off-ramp doesn't actually touch the building. Visitors to the building will notice that the elevator doesn't stop at floors five, six, or seven because these floors provide the space for the road.






