Everybody's Talking

White cukes: Most vegetable gardeners are familiar with green cucumbers, but not many may be aware that there is such a thing as a white cucumber. This variety is known by many names, including White Wonder, White Albino, Ivory King, and Jack Frost. This cucumber was first developed by a seed company in the United States in the late 1800s. It took the company several years to test and evaluate the fruit before commercializing the seed. While their foliage is green, these cucumbers have white skin, and the fruit is crisp and delicious.

Death Valley is one of the hottest places on Earth and the driest in North America.

Chilton, who lives in the UK, applies body paint and makeup to her face. When complete, she may look like a dinosaur, a skull, or a mummy, to name just a few. She has quite a following and hopes to one day make her living using her craft, which she began just for fun in 2018 during time off from her job as a chef.

**Recipe of the
month**

**Balsamic Watermelon
Chicken Salad**

- | | |
|-----------------------------------------|-----------------------------------|
| 1 cup balsamic vinegar | 1 tablespoons olive oil |
| 1 lb. boneless skinless chicken breasts | 4 cups baby spinach or greens |
| 3 teaspoons all purpose seasoning | 2 cups cubed watermelon |
| | 1/2 cup blue cheese crumbles |
| | 1/4 cup sliced or crushed almonds |

Prep Time: 10 mins. Cook time: 30 mins. Yield: 4 servings

1. Pour the balsamic vinegar into a small saucepan and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer for 15-20 minutes until the balsamic vinegar is significantly reduced and starting to become syrupy.
2. Meanwhile, turn a grill or nonstick skillet to high heat. Sprinkle the chicken with the seasoning on both sides and drizzle with the olive oil. Transfer to the hot grill and cook until no longer pink on the inside and nicely browned on the outside. Let rest for 5 minutes; cut into small cubes.
3. Layer the spinach with the chicken, watermelon, blue cheese, almonds, and drizzle with the balsamic reduction to taste. Top with additional olive oil if desired.
