Everybody's Talking

White cukes: Most vegetable gardeners are familiar with green cucumbers, but not many may be aware that there is such a thing as a white cucumber. This variety is known by many names, including White Wonder, White Albino, Ivory King, and Jack Frost. This cucumber was first developed by a seed company in the United States in the late 1800s. 


