**White cukes:** Most vegetable gardeners are familiar with green cucumbers, but not many may be aware that there is such a thing as a white cucumber. This variety is known by many names, including White Wonder, White Albino, Ivory King, and Jack Frost. This cucumber was first developed by a seed company in the United States in the late 1800s. Chilton, who lives in the UK, applies body paint and makeup to her face. When complete, she may look like a dinosaur, a skull, or a mummy, to name just a few. When she finishes a creation, she takes pictures of herself to post and then washes the paint off. She has quite a following and hopes to one day make her living using her craft, which she began just for fun in 2018 during time off from her job as a chef.

## Recipe of the month

### Jalapeno-Lime Chicken Drumsticks

1 jar (10 ounces) red jalapeno pepper jelly  
1/4 cup lime juice

12 chicken drumsticks (about 3 pounds)  
1 teaspoon salt  
1/2 teaspoon pepper

Prep/Total Time: 25 mins. Yield: 6 servings

- In a small saucepan, heat jelly and lime juice over medium heat until melted. Set aside 1/2 cup for serving.
- Sprinkle chicken with salt and pepper. On a greased grill rack, grill chicken, covered, over medium heat 15-20 minutes or until a thermometer reads 170°-175°, turning occasionally and basting with remaining jelly mixture during the last 5 minutes of cooking. Serve with reserved jelly mixture.
