Everybody's Talking

White cukes: Most vegetable gardeners are familiar with green cucumbers, but not many may be aware that there is such a thing as a white cucumber. This type is known by many names, including White Wonder, White Albino, Ivory King, and Jack Frost. This cucumber was first developed by a seed company in the United States in the late 1800s. It took the company several years to test and evaluate the fruit before commercializing the seed. While their foliage is green, these cucumbers have white skin, and the fruit is crisp and delicious.

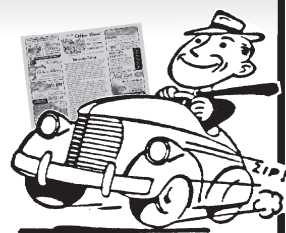

Recipe of the month




Jalapeno-Lime Chicken Drumsticks

1 jar (10 ounces) red jalapeno pepper jelly
1/4 cup lime juice

12 chicken drumsticks (about 3 pounds)
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper

Prep/Total Time: 25 mins. Yield: 6 servings

- In a small saucepan, heat jelly and lime juice over medium heat until melted. Set aside 1/2 cup for serving.
- Sprinkle chicken with salt and pepper. On a greased grill rack, grill chicken, covered, over medium heat 15-20 minutes or until a thermometer reads 170°-175°, turning occasionally and basting with remaining jelly mixture during the last 5 minutes of cooking. Serve with reserved jelly mixture.






