Recipe of the month

Jalapeno-Lime Chicken Drumsticks

1 jar (10 ounces) red jalapeno pepper jelly
1/4 cup lime juice

12 chicken drumsticks (about 3 pounds)
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper

Prep/Total Time: 25 mins. Yield: 6 servings

- In a small saucepan, heat jelly and lime juice over medium heat until melted. Set aside 1/2 cup for serving.
- Sprinkle chicken with salt and pepper. On a greased grill rack, grill chicken, covered, over medium heat 15-20 minutes or until a thermometer reads 170°-175°, turning occasionally and basting with remaining jelly mixture during the last 5 minutes of cooking. Serve with reserved jelly mixture.

Tough love: A woman's urge to be motherly has its limits for one matriarch in Mexico. The mother of Christian Uriel, a full-grown adult over the age 30, was happy to let her son come home to live free-of-charge when he lost his job due to the COVID-19 epidemic. However, months later, after Uriel had done little in the house except play video games, his mom had had enough. With the help of her sister, she ordered him out. The two women threw water on him and threatened him with brooms. Uriel filed a complaint to the authorities, but whose side they will take on the matter is unknown.
