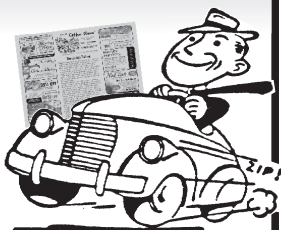

Tough love: A woman's urge to be motherly has its limits for one matriarch in Mexico. The mother of Christian Uriel, a full-grown adult over the age 30, was happy to let her son come home to live free-of-charge when he lost his job due to the COVID-19 epidemic. Recipe of the month

Jalapeno-Lime Chicken Drumsticks

- 1 jar (10 ounces) red jalapeno pepper jelly
- 1/4 cup lime juice
- 12 chicken drumsticks (about 3 pounds)
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon pepper

Prep/Total Time: 25 mins. Yield: 6 servings

- 1 In a small saucepan, heat jelly and lime juice over medium heat until melted. Set aside 1/2 cup for serving.
- 2 Sprinkle chicken with salt and pepper. On a greased grill rack, grill chicken, covered, over medium heat 15-20 minutes or until a thermometer reads 170°-175°, turning occasionally and basting with remaining jelly mixture during the last 5 minutes of cooking. Serve with reserved jelly mixture.
