Tough love: A woman's urge to be motherly has its limits for one matriarch in Mexico. Recipe of the month

Jalapeno-Lime Chicken Drumsticks

1 jar (10 ounces) red jalapeno pepper jelly
1/4 cup lime juice

12 chicken drumsticks (about 3 pounds)
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper

Prep/Total Time: 25 mins. Yield: 6 servings

- 1 In a small saucepan, heat jelly and lime juice over medium heat until melted. Set aside 1/2 cup for serving.
- 2 Sprinkle chicken with salt and pepper. On a greased grill rack, grill chicken, covered, over medium heat 15-20 minutes or until a thermometer reads 170°-175°, turning occasionally and basting with remaining jelly mixture during the last 5 minutes of cooking. Serve with reserved jelly mixture.
