Tough love: A woman's urge to be motherly has its limits for one matriarch in Mexico. The mother of Christian Uriel, a full-grown adult over the age 30, was happy to let her son come home to live free-of-charge when he lost his job due to the COVID-19 epidemic. However, months later, after Uriel had done little in the house except play video games, his mom had had enough. With the help of her sister, she ordered him out. The two women threw water on him and threatened him with brooms. Uriel filed a complaint to the authorities, but whose side they will take on the matter is unknown.

Tattooed teacher: A schoolteacher in Essonne, France, may lose his job, but not because of a lack of teaching ability. Actually, Sylvian Helaine is very good at his job. Recipe of the month




Balsamic Watermelon Chicken Salad

1 cup balsamic vinegar | 1 tablepoons olive oil
 1 lb. boneless skinless chicken breasts | 4 cups baby spinach or greens
 3 teaspoons all purpose seasoning | 2 cups cubed watermelon
 1/2 cup blue cheese crumbles | 1/4 cup sliced or crushed almonds

Prep Time: 10 mins. Cook time: 30 mins. Yield: 4 servings

- Pour the balsamic vinegar into a small saucepan and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and simmer for 15-20 minutes until the balsamic vinegar is significantly reduced and starting to become syrupy.
- Meanwhile, turn a grill or nonstick skillet to high heat. Sprinkle the chicken with the seasoning on both sides and drizzle with the olive oil. Transfer to the hot grill and cook until no longer pink on the inside and nicely browned on the outside. Let rest for 5 minutes; cut into small cubes.
- Layer the spinach with the chicken, watermelon, blue cheese, almonds, and drizzle with the balsamic reduction to taste. Top with additional olive oil if desired.
