Bird art: When Hannah Bullen-Ryner goes for a walk in the woods, she looks for more than just nice scenery. She scours the earth for petals, seeds, evergreen sprigs, sticks, and berries. From these natural items, she creates images of different kinds of birds, such as owls, chickadees, and hummingbirds. She crafts some as they are in flight, while others sit calmly on a branch. The birds are known as land art because she arranges her masterpieces on the ground. With a background in painting and photography, Bullen-Ryner's work is rich in detail and colour.

Long course: Golfers accustomed to 18-hole courses that take a few hours to complete might want to challenge themselves at Nullarbor Links in Australia. This course is 1,365 kilometres (848 mi.) long. It is located along the Eyre Highway, which runs between Ceduna in South Australia to Kalgoorlie in Western Australia. There are 18 holes; 11 were created for the course and seven are on established courses.



Spicy Cajun **Potato Salad** 5 pounds medium Yukon Gold potatoes, peeled and 1-1/2 cups mayonnaise with olive oil and coarsely cut into 3/4-inch cubes ground pepper 1 large yellow onion 1/2 medium lemon 1 cup dill pickle relish 1/4 cup yellow mustard 1 to 2 tablespoons Cajun 1/2 teaspoon salt 8 hard-boiled large eggs. 1/4 cup minced fresh parsley Paprika Prep Time: 20 min. Cook Time: 10 min. + chilling Yield: 20 servings $oldsymbol{0}$ Place potatoes in a Dutch oven; add water to cover. Cut onion in half crosswise; add one half to saucepan. Bring to a boil. Add lemon and salt to cooking water. Reduce heat; cook, uncovered, until potatoes tender, 5-6 minutes.

Meanwhile, chop remaining onion. Combine with eggs, mayonnaise, dill pickle relish, mustard and Cajun seasoning Train potatoes; rinse under cold water. Discard onion and lemon. Add potatoes to egg mixture; gently toss until well mixed (do not overmix, or potatoes will break down) Refrigerate, covered, 1-2 hours
Just before serving, sprinkle with parsley and paprika. www.tasteofhome.com
