Glow in the dark: An American artist with a love of photography and black light found a new canvas to create images: the human body. 

Light the way: The Fisgard Lighthouse, located near Victoria, British Columbia (Canada), started guiding boats into Esquimalt Harbour in 1860. Automated in 1929, the lighthouse is still operating today and is a National Historic Site.


