The brand is the brainchild of Costa Rican confectioner, Lorena Rodriguez, whose collection has something for everyone. Rodriguez always loved baking cookies, and her husband convinced her to go into business. Now, she has many molds for a wide variety of shapes, which she ornately decorates with fondant. Buyers can order any shape, from a horse on a carousel to the Eiffel Tower to a grandfather clock. The options are almost limitless!

The game played is "duckpin," which employs shorter lanes and lighter weight balls than the five- or 10-pin varieties. The bowlingalley-on-wheels is available for parties and events.
