Everybody's Talking

Phone fiend: People collect lots of different things, like dolls, hats, and porcelain figurines. 

Pumpkin Spice Cupcakes

1 can (15 ounces) pumpkin
4 large eggs, room temperature
1 cup canola oil
2 cups all-purpose flour
2 teaspoons baking powder
2 teaspoon baking soda
½ teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon ground ginger
1/4 teaspoon ground cloves
1 cup raisins
1/3 cup butter, softened
3 ounces cream cheese, softer.
1 teaspoon salt

2 cups confertion

1/3 cup butter, softened
3 ounces cream cheese, softened
1 teaspoon vanilla extract
2 cups confectioners' sugar
1/2 cup chopped walnuts, toasted

Prep Time: 30 min. Bake: 30 min + cooling Yield: 2 dozen

out clean, 28-32 minutes. Cool 10 minutes before rentrom pans to wire racks to cool completely.

© For frosting, beat butter and cream cheese until smooth. Beat in vanilla. Gradually add confectioners' sugar. Frost cupcakes; sprinkle with walnuts. Refrigerate.
