Everybody's Talking

Phone fiend: People collect lots of different things, like dolls, hats, and porcelain figurines. Recipe of the month



Creamy Ham and Potato Soup


4 strips of bacon
 1/2 cup onion, finely chopped
 4 medium potatoes, peeled and diced (about 3 cups)
 3 tablespoons all-purpose flour
 4 cups chicken broth (or 2 tablespoons chicken bouillon powder + 4 cups water)

1 + 1/2 cups cooked ham, cut into 1/2-inch cubes
 1 cup frozen corn
 1/2 cup heavy cream
 1/2 teaspoon ground black pepper salt (to taste)
 1 teaspoon fresh parsley, finely chopped

Prep Time: 5 mins. Cook Time: 20 mins. Yield: 4-6 servings

- Sauté bacon in a large stockpot or Dutch oven over medium high heat (no cooling oil needed) until crisp, about 3-4 minutes. Set the bacon aside on a plate.
- Add onion and potatoes and sauté for 1-2 minutes until fragrant. Stir in flour and mix well to combine until flour is fully incorporated. Stir in chicken broth and mix until the soup is smooth and uniform. Bring the soup to a boil over medium high heat. Cover and let it continue to boil for 10-15 minutes until potatoes are fork tender.
- Mash half of the potatoes in the pot with a potato masher or blend with a handheld immersion blender.
- Stir in ham, corn, heavy cream and black pepper. Let the soup simmer over medium heat and whisk occasionally until thickened to a desired consistency, about 5 minutes. If the chowder gets too thick, add a little bit more water to dilute it. Add salt to taste.
- Serve warm; top with crispy bacon and fresh parsley.
