## Everybody's Talking

Ozcelik is a cell phone repairman, and during his 20-odd years in business, he has seen a lot of different makes and models come and go. He has about 1,000 phones in his collection, and he used to have more before thieves broke in and stole some of them. He keeps them all in working order.

He got the idea while watching a boat from an airplane window. He named his creation "Zip-Fastener Ship" and presented it at the 2020 Designart Tokyo, calling his installation "Opening the River."

Delicious stew: Those who have visited Brazil may be well aware that this South American country's national dish is a stew called feijoada (feijoada completa). Finding exact replicas of the dish throughout the country is difficult because families and dining establishments boast their own homemade recipes for the popular mealtime favourite. 



## Did You Know...
