Everybody's Talking

A perfect circle: Bridges aren't usually in the form of a circle, but rather span the distance between two ends. However, there is a bridge in Kromlauer Park in Gablenz, Saxony, Germany, that appears to be a circle. Called the Rakotzbrücke Devil's Bridge, it looks to be circular because its arch is reflected in the water below. The bridge was built in the mid-1800s, making the illusion even more magical. The builders could not have known that the bridge would become famous to people around the world, 150 years later, due to the advent of social media.

Breezy building: In Jaipur, Rajasthan, India, there is a beautiful building called Hawa Mahal, which means "Palace of the Winds." This five-story structure has an astounding 953 windows adorned with elaborate designs. Built in 1799, the building was developed for women of the royal class to stroll through and watch the activity on the street; they did not go out in public. The building is very narrow, so the rooms behind the screened windows form something similar to a big porch. Because it was constructed with red and pink sandstone, the building has a pinkish hue.

Egg art: Most people wouldn't consider an ostrich egg as a medium for a work of art, but Nguyen Hung Cuong of Hanoi, Vietnam, had a vision. He hollowed out an egg and drilled tiny holes into it to create an intricate pattern. He worked on the project for three years, drilling over 45,800 minuscule holes. Some holes are so small that they are barely visible. The holes were counted with the use of computer technology. He has practiced his art using chicken eggs, but he found the ostrich egg to be more difficult because it is thicker and harder to drill through.

Noodle dessert: Someone seeking a cold treat on a hot day need look no further than the South Korean specialty of shiltarae bingsu. This dessert is made from exceptionally fine ice shavings; when piled onto a plate, they appear to be a stack of vermicelli noodles. Confectioners use a special machine to shave the ice, which can be flavoured with such things as green tea, coffee, and mascarpone cheese. The strands are carefully stacked onto a plate and served with a scoop of ice cream, some red beans, and a few cubed rice cakes. The milky dessert is a pleasure to consume.

Recipe of the month

Chocolate Covered Strawberry Christmas Trees

12 ounces dark green candy melts
 1 pound of strawberries, stems removed
 24 Oreos
 white icing
 sprinkles
 candy stars

Icing:
 2 1/2 cups powdered sugar
 3 tablespoons heavy cream
 Add water by the teaspoon and whisk until the desired consistency is reached. You want it to be thick like toothpaste.

Prep Time: 15 min. Cook Time: 10 min. Yield: 24

- Set a heat proof bowl over a small pot of simmering water on the stovetop (double boiler). Slowly melt the candy melts in the bowl, stirring occasionally. Do not allow moisture to come in contact with the candy.
- Spoon or pipe a small amount of icing onto the top of each Oreo. This will adhere the strawberry to the cookie base.
- Once candy melts are fully melted, turn the heat to low while you dip the strawberries using a toothpick inserted into the cut end.
- Shake off excess candy coating gently. Using a second toothpick inserted into the pointed end of the dipped strawberry, carefully place the strawberry on top of the icing on the Oreo.
- Decorate with sprinkles and a candy star while the candy coating is still wet. It will usually dry in about 10 minutes.
