## Everybody's Talking

**Colourful field:** People driving by a field of leeks at night near the town of Lelystad, Netherlands, have been known to stop and gawk. This is not because leeks are an amazing vegetable, but because the field is glowing with blue, red, and purple light. The ultraviolet glow comes from a lighting system designed by Dutch artist Daan Roosegaarde. In addition to being beautiful, the project, called GROW, has a practical purpose: the artist and his team are experimenting with light to see how different wavelengths can enhance plant growth.

**Airport home:** For three months, the O'Hare International Airport in Chicago, Illinois (U.S.), became the unauthorized home of a man named Aditya Singh. Jones and his wife, Michelle, think that Billy faked his limp in order to commiserate with his owner. They thought this because when Jones wasn't home, Billy would run around the yard with no limp at all!

## Recipe of the month

### Creamy Ham and Potato Soup

4 strips of bacon  
½ cup onion, finely chopped  
4 medium potatoes, peeled and diced (about 3 cups)  
3 tablespoons all-purpose flour  
4 cups chicken broth (or 2 tablespoons chicken bouillon powder + 4 cups water)

1 + ½ cups cooked ham, cut into ½-inch cubes  
1 cup frozen corn  
½ cup heavy cream  
½ teaspoon ground black pepper salt (to taste)  
1 teaspoon fresh parsley, finely chopped

Prep Time: 5 mins. Cook Time: 20 mins. Yield: 4-6 servings

1. Sauté bacon in a large stockpot or Dutch oven over medium high heat (no cooking oil needed) until crisp, about 3-4 minutes. Set the bacon aside on a plate.
2. Add onion and potatoes and sauté for 1-2 minutes until fragrant. Stir in flour and mix well to combine until flour is fully incorporated. Stir in chicken broth and mix until the soup is smooth and uniform. Bring the soup to a boil over medium high heat. Cover and let it continue to boil for 10-15 minutes until potatoes are fork tender.
3. Mash half of the potatoes in the pot with a potato masher or blend with a handheld immersion blender.
4. Stir in ham, corn, heavy cream and black pepper. Let the soup simmer over medium heat and whisk occasionally until thickened to a desired consistency, about 5 minutes. If the chowder gets too thick, add a little bit more water to dilute it. Add salt to taste.
5. Serve warm; top with crispy bacon and fresh parsley.

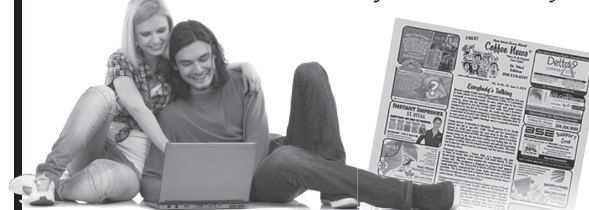
