Heart-shaped lakes: In an oasis called Al Qudra, near the city of Dubai, United Arab Emirates, is a manmade attraction called Love Lake. Recipe of the month

Savoury Winter Soup

2 pounds ground beef	1 cup each diced carrots and celery
3 medium onions, chopped	1 cup fresh or frozen cut green beans
1 garlic clove, minced	1 cup cubed peeled potatoes
3 cans (10-1/2 ounces each) condensed beef broth, undiluted	2 tablespoons minced fresh parsley or 2 teaspoons dried parsley flakes
1 can (28 ounces) diced tomatoes, undrained	1 teaspoon dried basil
3 cups water	1/2 teaspoon dried thyme
	Salt and pepper to taste

Prep Time: 20 min. Cook Time: 6 hours
 Yield: 14 servings (3.5 quarts)

- 1 In a large skillet, cook beef and onions over medium heat until meat is no longer pink. Add garlic; cook 1 minute longer. Drain.
- 2 Transfer to a 5-qt. slow cooker. Stir in remaining ingredients. Cover and cook on low until vegetables are tender, 6-8 hours.
