1 large egg 4 tbsp. raspberry jam

Prep Time: 10 min. Cook Time: 13 minutes Yield: 4

• Preheat the oven to 425 degrees F. Line a jelly-roll pan with parchment paper.

 Unroll the piecrust and cut into 8 rectangles or hearts. Use a small heart-shaped cookie cutter to stamp out smaller hearts from half the hearts (these will be your peekaboo top crusts); brush edges with egg. Spread 1 heaping teaspoon raspberry jam in the centre of the 4 solid hearts. Put the peekaboo crusts on top; seal the edges by crimping them with a fork (lightly floured, if needed). Transfer to prepared iellv-roll pan.

Bake 10 to 13 minutes or until golden. Transfer to wire racks to cool.
