Guava king: An Indian man is being honoured for his contribution to the environment after years of working hard to develop an orchard on barren land. Satyendra Guatam Manjhi lives in Imaliyachak, a small village in the Indian state of Bihar. Accomplishing this was difficult. He began by hauling water to the land to nourish the plants, but wild animals kept destroying them. So he planted a ring of thorny bushes around the area to deter the animals. This tactic worked, and 15 years later he has an orchard of about 10,000 guava trees, as a result of his labour. Recipe of the month

Savoury Winter Soup



2 pounds ground beef	1 cup each diced carrots and celery
3 medium onions, chopped	1 cup fresh or frozen cut green beans
1 garlic clove, minced	1 cup cubed peeled potatoes
3 cans (10-1/2 ounces each) condensed beef broth, undiluted	2 tablespoons minced fresh parsley or 2 teaspoons dried parsley flakes
1 can (28 ounces) diced tomatoes, undrained	1 teaspoon dried basil
3 cups water	1/2 teaspoon dried thyme
	Salt and pepper to taste

Prep Time: 20 min. Cook Time: 6 hours
Yield: 14 servings (3.5 quarts)

- In a large skillet, cook beef and onions over medium heat until meat is no longer pink. Add garlic; cook 1 minute longer. Drain.
- Transfer to a 5-qt. slow cooker. Stir in remaining ingredients. Cover and cook on low until vegetables are tender, 6-8 hours.
