## Everybody's Talking

**Guava king:** An Indian man is being honoured for his contribution to the environment after years of working hard to develop an orchard on barren land. Satyendra Guatam Manjhi lives in Imaliyachak, a small village in the Indian state of Bihar. Accomplishing this was difficult. He began by hauling water to the land to nourish the plants, but wild animals kept destroying them. So he planted a ring of thorny bushes around the area to deter the animals. This tactic worked, and 15 years later he has an orchard of about 10,000 guava trees, as a result of his labour. Now, along with enriching the environment, he is able to make a living by selling the fruit.

# Recipe of the month

## Savoury Winter Soup

2 pounds ground beef  
3 medium onions, chopped  
1 garlic clove, minced  
3 cans (10-1/2 ounces each) condensed beef broth, undiluted  
1 can (28 ounces) diced tomatoes, undrained  
3 cups water


1 cup each diced carrots and celery  
1 cup fresh or frozen cut green beans  
1 cup cubed peeled potatoes  
2 tablespoons minced fresh parsley or 2 teaspoons dried parsley flakes  
1 teaspoon dried basil  
1/2 teaspoon dried thyme  
Salt and pepper to taste

Prep Time: 20 min. Cook Time: 6 hours  
Yield: 14 servings (3.5 quarts)

- In a large skillet, cook beef and onions over medium heat until meat is no longer pink. Add garlic; cook 1 minute longer. Drain.
- Transfer to a 5-qt. slow cooker. Stir in remaining ingredients. Cover and cook on low until vegetables are tender, 6-8 hours.
