**3D retirement:** A retired Dutch couple moved into a rented home in Eindhoven, a suburb of Bosrijk. This sounds like a standard thing to do, but this case is a special endeavour: they are the first people in Europe to live in a 3D-printed house. Elize Lutz and Harrie Dekkers will live in the two-bedroom bungalow, which looks a little like a big boulder with windows, for six months, at a reduced rent. The home was designed by participants in Project Milestone at the Eindhoven University of Technology. Lutz and Dekkers will keep track of their experiences living in the 3D home as a way of documenting the technology's viability.




## Did You Know..
