

Did You Know..

Trick or treat: Dressing in costume and going door-to-door soliciting treats has been a part of various rituals since the Middle Ages. But the phrase "trick or treat" is thought to have been first used in the town of Blackie, Alberta (Canada), in 1927.

Invented name: Awkwafina is an American rapper and actress who has starred in such movies as Ocean's 8 and Crazy Rich Asians. Born Nora Lum, she made up the stage name "Awkwafina" when she was a teenager.


