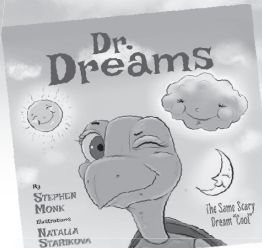

Recipe of the month

Asian-Style Salmon Packets

- | | |
|----------------------------------|------------------------------------|
| 4 slices sweet onion | 1 teaspoon mustard seed |
| 4 salmon fillets (6 ounces each) | 1 teaspoon minced fresh gingerroot |
| 3 tablespoons chili sauce | ½ teaspoon black sesame seeds |
| 1 tablespoon lime juice | Chopped fresh mint |
| 1 tablespoon sesame oil | Grated lime zest |
| 1 garlic clove, minced | |

Prep/Total Time: 25 min. Yield: 4 servings

- Preheat oven to 400°. Place each onion slice on a double thickness of heavy-duty foil (about 12 in. square). Top with salmon. Combine next seven ingredients; spoon over fillets. Fold foil around mixture; crimp edges to seal.
- Place on a baking sheet. Bake until fish flakes easily with a fork, 15-20 minutes. Be careful of escaping steam when opening packets. Serve with mint and lime zest.

Did You Know...
