



# Did You Know...

**Trick or treat:** Dressing in costume and going door-to-door soliciting treats has been a part of various rituals since the Middle Ages. But the phrase "trick or treat" is thought to have been first used in the town of Blackie, Alberta (Canada), in 1927.

**Invented name:** Awkwafina is an American rapper and actress who has starred in such movies as *Ocean's 8* and *Crazy Rich Asians*. Born Nora Lum, she made up the stage name "Awkwafina" when she was a teenager.

**Green soap:** The term "green soap" refers to an environmentally friendly soap made from vegetable oil rather than animal fat. Other plant-sourced oils can also be used, such as coconut or olive oil. Green soap is often used by tattoo artists to soften the skin.

**New pasta:** Many pasta shapes are available, from spaghetti to macaroni to rigatoni. A new one on the market is cascatelli. Its name comes from the Italian word for waterfall; curved half-tubes with ruffles help hold sauce and provide texture. It was invented by Dan Pashman of New York City.


