Recipe of the month

Asian-Style Salmon Packets

4 slices sweet onion	1 teaspoon mustard seed
4 salmon fillets (6 ounces each)	1 teaspoon minced fresh gingerroot
3 tablespoons chili sauce	1/2 teaspoon black sesame seeds
1 tablespoon lime juice	Chopped fresh mint
1 tablespoon sesame oil	Grated lime zest
1 garlic clove, minced	

Prep/Total Time: 25 min. Yield: 4 servings

- Preheat oven to 400°. Place each onion slice on a double thickness of heavy-duty foil (about 12 in. square). Top with salmon. Combine next seven ingredients; spoon over fillets. Fold foil around mixture; crimp edges to seal.
- Place on a baking sheet. Bake until fish flakes easily with a fork, 15-20 minutes. Be careful of escaping steam when opening packets. Serve with mint and lime zest.
