Recipe of the month
Asian-Style Salmon Packets
4 slices sweet onion
4 salmon fillets (6 ounces each)
3 tablespoons chili sauce
1 tablespoon lime juice
1 tablespoon sesame oil
1 garlic clove, minced
1 teaspoon mustard seed
1 teaspoon minced fresh gingerroot
1/2 teaspoon black sesame seeds
Chopped fresh mint
Grated lime zest
Prep/Total Time: 25 min. Yield: 4 servings
1 Preheat oven to 400°. Place each onion slice on a double thickness of heavy-duty foil (about 12 in. square). Top with salmon. Combine next seven ingredients; spoon over fillets. Fold foil around mixture; crimp edges to seal.
2 Place on a baking sheet. Bake until fish flakes easily with a fork, 15-20 minutes. Be careful of escaping steam when opening packets. Serve with mint and lime zest.
