Everybody's Talking

Great big worm: Most people have seen a robin plucking an earthworm from the ground. Those worms are not usually very long. But there is a region in Australia where the earthworms are so big that a robin would have difficulty catching one for dinner. Called Giant Gippsland Earthworms, these squiggly creatures are now found only around south and west Gippsland, in the state of Victoria. They can grow to be as long as two meters (6.6 ft.) in length. They are elusive, living in underground burrows, only appearing on the surface during times of heavy rain. It is thought that these worms live to be 10 to even 20 years old.

Narrow city: Yanjin, in China's Yunnan Province, sits along both sides of the Nanxi River. What's spectacular about this city is its narrowness. On both sides of the Nanxi are rocky cliffs that drop to the water, with steep mountains behind, leaving very little land upon which to build. However, structures have been erected; many are numerous stories high. These buildings commonly have stilts at their bases to protect them from rising river waters. The city is only 30 meters (98 ft.) at its narrowest point, and about 300 meters (985 ft.) at the widest part. Only one main road goes along the river on either side; the city stretches alongside for many kilometers, but with few bridges.

Real-life hermit: A Serbian man named Panta Petrovic got tired of living a normal life in the city, where money was king and material possessions were important. So, over 15 years ago, he retreated from city life and started living as a hermit. For part of the year, he lives in a hidden cave, and for the other part, he stays in a tree house. Petrovic lives simply, sleeping on the ground and bathing in the river. He shares his life with many pets, including dogs, cats, and ducks, and he even has a wild boar named Mara whom he acquired as a piglet. He is well known in the area, and local folk occasionally come to visit, bringing food for the animals.

Spidermania: People who love tattoos have lots of options for designs: flowers, birds, celebrity faces, skulls, and crossbones. The choices are endless. But Jesse Garcia, a tattoo artist in Los Angeles, California (U.S.), specializes in inking black widow spiders onto his clients' skin. These tattoo spiders are extremely realistic, have a 3D element to them, and look like they are actually sitting on the person's arm, shoulder, or leg. On many of his designs, Garcia will add a web as well. It may not be for everyone, especially those who are afraid of spiders. But for those who want an attention-getting tattoo, Garcia's studio may be the place to consider.

Recipe of the month

Strawberry-Rhubarb Pops

3 cups chopped fresh or frozen rhubarb (½ inch)
1/4 cup sugar
3 tablespoons water
1 cup strawberry yogurt
½ cup unsweetened applesauce

1/4 cup finely chopped fresh strawberries
2 drops red food colouring, optional
8 freezer pop molds or 8 paper cups (3 ounces each and wooden pop sticks)

Prep: 10 min. + freezing Cook: 15 min. + cooling
Yield: 8 pops

1 Place rhubarb, sugar and water in a large saucepan; bring to a boil. Reduce heat; simmer, uncovered, until thick and blended, 10-15 minutes. Remove 3/4 cup mixture to a bowl; cool completely. (Save remaining rhubarb for another use.)
2 Add yogurt, applesauce and strawberries to bowl; stir until blended. If desired, tint with food colouring. Fill each mold or cup with about 1/4 cup rhubarb mixture. Top molds with holders; top cups with foil and insert sticks through foil. Freeze until firm.
