

Recipe of the month



Fresh Corn and Tomato Fettucine

8 ounces uncooked whole wheat fettucine
2 medium ears sweet corn, husked
2 teaspoons plus 2 table-spoons olive oil, divided
1/2 cup chopped sweet red pepper
4 green onions, chopped
2 medium tomatoes, chopped
1/2 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper
1 cup crumbled feta cheese
2 tablespoons minced fresh parsley

Prep/Total Time: 30 min. Yield: 4 servings

- In a Dutch oven, cook fettucine according to package directions, adding corn during the last 8 minutes of cooking.
- Meanwhile, in a small skillet, heat 2 teaspoons oil over medium-high heat. Add red pepper and green onions; cook and stir until tender.
- Drain pasta and corn; transfer pasta to a large bowl. Cool corn slightly; cut corn from cob and add to pasta. Add tomatoes, salt, pepper, remaining oil and the pepper mixture; toss to combine. Sprinkle with cheese and parsley.

Everybody's Talking

Ghost busters: In China, if a house is deemed "haunted," real estate agents have a tough job trying to sell the property to new owners. To provide proof that ghosts do not live in the home, agents can pay a haunted house tester ¥1,440 to stay in the place for 24 hours. These freelancers will travel around the country to test a home, sometimes setting up video calls with potential owners to show them that the place is ghost-free. The testers get paid for their efforts, but the work is not steady. One retired man who provides the service explained that the job is a good way to make extra income outside of a day job.

Sitting and talking: What better way to end the day than to sit and visit with neighbours? People in the southern Spain town of Algar have been doing that for centuries. After a hot day of working in the fields, an enduring custom is to pull chairs to the street, and sit and chat with anyone who joins the group. To try to maintain the custom in the face of social media, town mayor José Carlos Sánchez applied to the United Nations to recognize the tradition as an intangible cultural heritage. Sánchez did this to encourage people to socialize together rather than focus on their devices. Whether the U.N. will recognize the tradition is not yet determined.

Optical illusion: South African land artist and sculptor Strijdom van der Merwe created an installation called "Staircase to Heaven." If a viewer stands in front of it, the structure made of steel tubing appears to live up to its name as a stairway that ascends far up into the sky. However, the piece is actually an optical illusion. In reality, the 4.5-metre (14.8-ft.) high structure is a flat, vertical ladder, which is obvious when viewing the "staircase" from the side. Van der Merwe's original work is at Creation Farm in South Africa's Hemel and Aarde Valley; the sculptor worked with Taiwanese artist Chou Sheng-hsien to create a near-replica for the 2021 Nanhui Art Project in Taiwan.

Puzzle solver: Solving a Rubik's cube is one thing, but solving the difficult puzzle 300 times while riding a unicycle is quite another. That's what Jesse Bradford of Brooks, Alberta (Canada), did, and he earned a Guinness World Record in 2021 for the accomplishment. His parents helped the teenager practice because they were sure he had the ability to break the previous record. Caleb McEvoy had set that one in 2018 by solving 250 Rubik's cubes while on a unicycle. Bradford achieved the new record while riding laps in a recreation centre and having six volunteers witness his feat. He'd only learned to ride a unicycle in 2020.
