Pet-friendly hotel: Anyone wishing to go on a holiday in Gloucester, England, who doesn't want to leave a pet canine behind, simply needs to make a reservation at the Tewkesbury Park Hotel. This hotel offers many activities for pet owners, such as playing golf, going for walks, enjoying a game of tennis, or having a spa treatment. Likewise, their canine companions can lounge in the luxurious rooms on their doggie beds, enjoy doggie treats, and wander through the gardens. Not only that, but guests are allowed to take their pet to dinner at the Piano Lounge, where both human and animal patrons can enjoy a meal of their liking.

Now, Kusic's wife can choose to have the house rotate as slowly as once every 24 hours, or at the dizzying rate of once every 22 seconds.
