Pet-friendly hotel: Anyone wishing to go on a holiday in Gloucester, England, who doesn't want to leave a pet canine behind, simply needs to make a reservation at the Tewkesbury Park Hotel. This hotel offers many activities for pet owners, such as playing golf, going for walks, enjoying a game of tennis, or having a spa treatment. Now, Kusic's wife can choose to have the house rotate as slowly as once every 24 hours, or at the dizzying rate of once every 22 seconds.


