She is a member of a group called Frugal Women's Federation. Growing up poor, she learned to do with less, and continues that lifestyle today.

Recipe of the month

Peppermint Meltaways

| | |
|---------------------------------|---|
| 1 cup butter, softened | 1/4 teaspoon peppermint extract |
| 1/2 cup confectioners' sugar | 2 to 3 drops red food colouring, optional |
| 1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract | 1-1/2 cups confectioners' sugar |
| 1-1/4 cups all-purpose flour | 1/2 cup crushed peppermint candies |
| 1/2 cup cornstarch | |
| 2 tablespoons butter, softened | |
| 2 tablespoons 2% milk | |

Prep Time: 30 min. + chilling Bake: 10 min./batch
 Yield: approx. 2.5 dozen

- 1 In a small bowl, cream butter and confectioners' sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in extract. In another bowl, whisk flour and cornstarch; gradually beat into creamed mixture. Refrigerate, covered, 30 minutes or until firm enough to handle.
- 2 Preheat oven to 350°. Shape dough into 1-in. balls; place 2 in. apart on ungreased baking sheets. Bake 9-11 minutes or until bottoms are light brown. Remove from pans to wire racks to cool completely.
- 3 In a small bowl, beat butter until creamy. Beat in milk, extract and, if desired, food colouring. Gradually beat in confectioners' sugar until smooth. Spread over cookies; sprinkle with crushed candies. Store in an airtight container.
