**Recipe of the month**

**Peppermint Meltaways**

1 cup butter, softened  
1/2 cup confectioners' sugar  
1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract  
1-1/4 cups all-purpose flour  
1/2 cup cornstarch  
2 tablespoons butter, softened  
2 tablespoons 2% milk

1/4 teaspoon peppermint extract  
2 to 3 drops red food colouring, optional  
1-1/2 cups confectioners' sugar  
1/2 cup crushed peppermint candies

Prep Time: 30 min. + chilling Bake: 10 min./batch  
Yield: approx. 2.5 dozen

1 In a small bowl, cream butter and confectioners' sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in extract. In another bowl, whisk flour and cornstarch; gradually beat into creamed mixture. Refrigerate, covered, 30 minutes or until firm enough to handle.  
2 Preheat oven to 350°. Shape dough into 1-in. balls; place 2 in. apart on ungreased baking sheets. Bake 9-11 minutes or until bottoms are light brown. Remove from pans to wire racks to cool completely.  
3 In a small bowl, beat butter until creamy. Beat in milk, extract and, if desired, food colouring. Gradually beat in confectioners' sugar until smooth. Spread over cookies; sprinkle with crushed candies. Store in an airtight container.

**Abandoned hotel:** Imagine heading to the beach but, instead of finding luxury hotels lining the shore, a derelict old mansion is sitting right in the water. That is what greets visitors to Playa La Puntilla in Costa del Sol, El Salvador, when they saunter down to the water's edge. There are theories about why the pillared, but wrecked, building is there.
